In this issue, we return to the bibliography. Our bibliographers, Ann M. Reed and Vicki Hansen Walker, have done a mammoth job, with the invaluable assistance of the Institute for the Advancement of Philosophy for Children, of tracking down sources that were missed in the 1982 effort, and of presenting an index to the enormous amount of work that has been done since 1982. We congratulate the bibliographers and everyone else involved in the project, and recommend the fruits of their labors to you.

On October 29, 30, and 31, 1987, the Center for Analytic Teaching at Texas Wesleyan College and the Texas Network in Teacher-Training in Philosophy for Children will sponsor a conference on Philosophy for Children. Two of the principle speakers will be Matthew Lipman and Ann Margaret Sharp. At this point, it appears that approximately twenty papers will be presented. We will print those papers in our May, 1988 issue.
