GRAZ CONFERENCE – JUNE 25 TO JUNE 28

The 5th International Conference on Philosophy for Children will be held in Graz, Austria, from June 25 to June 28, 1992. Thursday, June 25 is reserved for registration and gathering. The conference officially opens on Friday, June 26. This conference will follow the ICPIC guidelines established at the Mexico City conference last April. These guidelines are intended to model a community of inquiry approach to the conference. This means that all papers are submitted and distributed to participants in advance of the conference, and conference "presenters" lead a community of inquiry discussion around their paper. The Graz conference will be primarily for practitioners in Philosophy for Children. Others interested in learning more about the program and/or general application and practices of community based inquiry are also welcome.

The Graz meeting will also include pre-conference and post conference activities. These activities are by invitation only. **Pre-conference – June 24 and 25.** Two activities are scheduled, a meeting of: (1) the Committee on Staff Development and (2) the newly formed European Federation of Philosophy for Children. **Post-conference – June 28, 29, and 30.** Meeting of Center Directors.
